Site Rules

There are a number of site rules that we need to follow;

- Follow the directions of the stewards
- You will be guided to a parking space which has a minimum 2m gap between cars
- Please stay in your car except in an emergency
- There are a couple of toilets if needed – stewards will help you find them

- It is acceptable to open your windows
- You should only have people from one household or 'bubble' in your car, maximum 6 people.
- If you have not pre-registered, you will be asked for a contact name, phone number and the registration of your car, or full postal address for legally required 'Test and Protect
- For those who are being given a lift to the service you will need to leave the car. You will be directed to an area where you can sit. Each household will need to remain seated in this area throughout the service. Please remember to bring your own deckchair. The seating areas will be outdoors – so please dress appropriately for the weather.
